Falling from heights while performing acrobatic manoeuvres.	Moderate to severe.	All participants will receive appropriate training and are matched with activities suitable for their skill level.	Low.
Collusions with other participants during group activities.	Moderate to severe.	Instructor will implement progressive learning and skill development programs.	Low.
Over-exertion leading to muscle strains or sprains.	Low.	Provide regular warmups, stretches and conditioning prior to performing tricks.	Low
Trips and slips on equipment or surfaces.	Moderate.	Training area is well lit and regular inspections are carried out on the training area and equipment and any risks are addressed promptly.	Low.
<i>Equipment Safety</i>			
Malfunction or failure of acrobatics equipment such as air tracks or mats.	Low.	Regular inspection and maintenance of all acrobatics equipment will be carried out ensuring they meet safety standards.	Low.

Inadequate or improper maintenance of equipment.	Low.	Instructor will ensure equipment maintenance and proper safety protocols.	Low.
<i>Instructor and Supervision</i>			
Lack of qualified instructors with proper acrobatics training and certification.	Low.	All instructors will have relevant acrobatics training and certification.	Low.
Insufficient supervision and monitoring of participants during activities.	Low.	Instructor will ensure adequate supervision ratio.	Low.
<i>Environmental factors</i>			
Inadequate lighting or ventilation in the training area.	Low.	Training area is well lit, properly ventilated and free from obstacles or hazards.	Low.
Presence of obstacles or hazards in the training area.	Low.	Regular inspections will be carried out on the training area for potential risks which will be addressed promptly.	Low.

Risk monitoring and review

Date for review: EVERY MONTH

Regular reviews and updates of this risk assessment will be carried out based on any incidents, near misses or changes to the acrobatics classes.

All participants, parents and staff are encouraged to report any safety concerns or incidents.

Periodic audits and inspections will be conducted to ensure compliance with safety protocols and risk control measures.
